

Charting the Path Forward

- 3 Options to Present
- Options can potentially be "mixed-and-matched"
- These are in-district options only at this time
- All costs are estimates at this time
- All timelines are approximate
- Flexibility and Creativity are Key!
- Input and Planning Team Being Created
- What about "just putting everything back the way it was"



Charting the Path Forward: Option I

- Acquire Pennside Elementary (Grades K-2)
- Renovate MPPC (Grades 9-12)
- "Reactivate" Central Office @MSHS site
- Construct Athletic "Complex" @MSHS site

Notes:

- Grades 3-8 Housed at MPEC ("School Within a School" created for grades 6-8)
- This option addresses all of the needs of the District, and is the most comprehensive
- The items in this option can be "spaced" as needed, and intermediate plans can be developed as needed



Charting the Path Forward: Option I Costs

Item/Action	Cost
Purchase/Lease Pennside School (w/additional improvements included)	\$1.6M - \$1.7M
Renovate MPPC Building	\$5.4M - \$8M
Raze MSHS and "Reactivate" Central Office at MSHS site	\$1.5M - \$1.75M
Construct Athletic Complex	\$1.5M - \$3M
Total Estimated Costs	\$10M - \$14.45M



Charting the Path Forward: Option II

- Renovate MPPC spaces (Grades 9-12)
- Re-configure current buildings (Grades K-5 or 3-8 at MPEC)
- Bring in modulars to fit-out rest of district (Grades K-2, or 6-8 and Central Office)

Notes:

- Does not address the MSHS site
- Does not include accommodations for athletics facility
- Could combine elements of Option I with Option II as needed (where feasible)
- Modulars are not "forever" and have a life span of 5-10 years



Charting the Path Forward: Option II Costs

Item/Action	Cost
Modulars	\$2.1M - \$3.1M *Does not include all infrastructure costs
Renovate MPPC Building	\$5.4M - \$8M
Total Estimated Costs	\$7.5M - \$11.1M



Charting the Path Forward: Option III

- Renovate MPPC- ONLY Ground Floor option
- Continue and/or Expand Albright Program
- Continue to use spaces at Trinity UCC (MSHS electives, possible central office spaces)

Notes:

- Does not give Central Office a "home"
- Does not address athletic accommodations
- Has yearly recurring costs associated with Albright program and transportation



Charting the Path Forward: Option III Costs

Item/Action	Cost
Renovate MPPC Building (Ground Floor Only)	\$2.5M - \$3M
Albright Costs (per year)	\$850,000 - \$1M (depending on class size)
Transportation Costs	\$110,000 per year
Total Estimated Costs	\$2.5M-\$3M (up front) + \$960,000 - \$1.1M (per year)



Charting the Path Forward: Estimated Timeline (Options I,II, and III)

School Year 2023-2024

October 2023 - February 2024

Move district storage to MSHS Cafeteria/Off-site Warehouse

February 2024 - May 2024

Renovations begin at MPPC

OPTION I ONLY: Begin "reactivation" of Central Office Site

OPTION II ONLY: Identify and Prepare Site(s) for Modular Units, Complete installation of Modular Units

Summer 2024

June 2024 - August 2024

Complete classroom moves/relocations based on Option I, II, or III

*Note: Option III complete at this phase - Options I and II continue contingent upon progress/planning
